ANNEXURE - II

A Summary Statement on progress made by local body in respect of waste collection, segregation, transportation and disposal

1. Collection of Solid Wastes :

Solid Waste Management is being handled by Aizawl Municipal Corporation and Commerce & Industries Department.

Collection is carried on by making various sanitation point in 83 (eighty three) localities through Municipal Agency, namely Local Councils.

Trade and Commerce Department separately collect wastes from market places by placing several RCC Bins in 5 (five) markets in the City.

As regard to Bio-medical Wastes, large quantities are treated as per the Bio-medical waste rule. Although the Hospitals and Helth Care authorities are aware of necessary conditions to be applied, a large quantity of them are still simply mixed with the Municipal Solid Waste. However, improvement is seen recently due to awareness programmes and interaction and interactions with the Health Care Facilities.

2. Segregation of Solid Wastes:

Waste are not segregated at any point.

3. Storage of Solid Wastes:

Under the UD&PA Deptt./ Aizawl Municipal Corporation, no storage facilities for municipal solid waste are established. Waste collected are directly transported to the place of disposal.

Commecre & Industries Department placed bins at different stations/markets within Aizawl City for collection of Market wastes. Additional 5 RCC bins are proposed.

4. Transportation of Solid Wastes:

Waste are transported by means of specially designed and covered waste Transportation vehicles.

5. Processing of Solid Wastes:

Scientific technologies are not yet adopted for processing wastes and so waste are neither processed nor recycled at present. However, attempts have been taken to adopt scientific technologies for processing of waste utilising technologies like composting, vermiculture etc.

6. Disposal of Solid Wastes:

Landfilling system is not yet adopted. The present system of Disposal of solid waste is 'Open Dumping' at the Dumping ground managed by Aizawl Municipal Corporation.

The State Investment Programme Implementation and Monitoring Unit (SIPMIU) identified landfilling site at Tuirial just adjacent to the present Dumping area.

The Trade and Commerce Department also identified a separate Disposal Site (i.e. Landfill- trench method) at Lengte, Mamit District. NOC was issued on 8th March, 2013 by the Board.
